# Acts Plus – an outline summary

### Authorship

Generally taken to be Luke as the second book written for Theophilus. (Literally: lover of God. May be one person or refer to any Jew or Christian.)

### Date

After Paul has been living in Rome for two years (60 – 62 AD suggested) After the fall of Jerusalem in 70 AD (Lk 19:41-44; 21:20-24)

# Comparisons in Luke's Gospel and the book of the Acts of the Apostles

Luke's Gospel	Acts of the Apostles
Covers ~ 3 ½ years (~0 to 30 AD)	Covers ~ 35 years ( ~ 30 to ~ 62 AD)
Set in Palestine – mostly between Jerusalem and	Set in Palestine, Syria, Asia Minor, Illyrium,
Galilee	Mediterranean Islands, Italy (Rome)
Range of travel ~ 100 miles S to N, ~30 W to E	Range of travel
	Jerusalem to Athens ~ 1800 miles (by land)
	Athens to Rome ~ 1200 miles (by sea)
Jesus' maximum single journey maybe ~ 120 miles	Estimates suggest that Paul travelled ~ 5000 miles
???	on foot and 5300 miles by sea over ~ 30 years.
	If he went to Spain this adds 1600 miles round trip
