The leader of the rebellion:

4 titles: Man of lawlessness

Defiant of moral (no moral absolutes) and civil law (anarchy)

Man doomed to destruction (Hb: 'his destiny is ruin')

The enemy (who will oppose everything that is called God)

The climber (who will exalt himself over . . . God. Seats himself in God's temple

proclaiming himself to be God)

(... but what is 'God's temple in this context?...)

"God and law, religion and ethics, are the two essential ingredients of culture which act as a glue to bond a community together, and are therefore two authorities which humankind have normally recognised. To oppose them is to undermine the foundations of society. More than that, Antichrist's godlessness and lawlessness will go beyond a denial of these basic authorities to demand that worship and obedience be given to him alone. Not anarchy, but totalitarianism is his goal." (p. 161)
